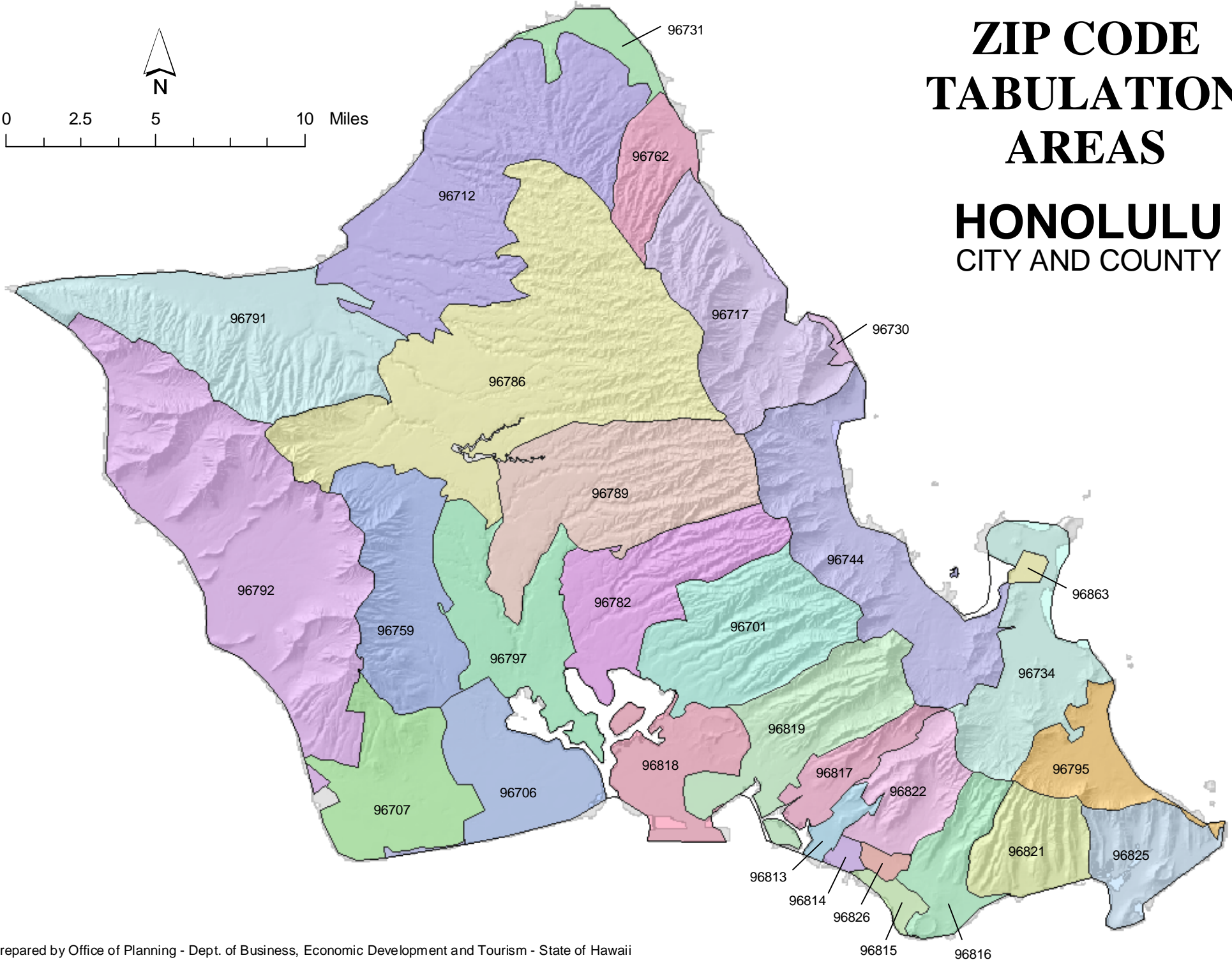
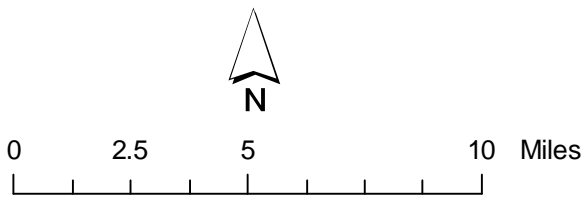

HONOLULU CITY AND COUNTY






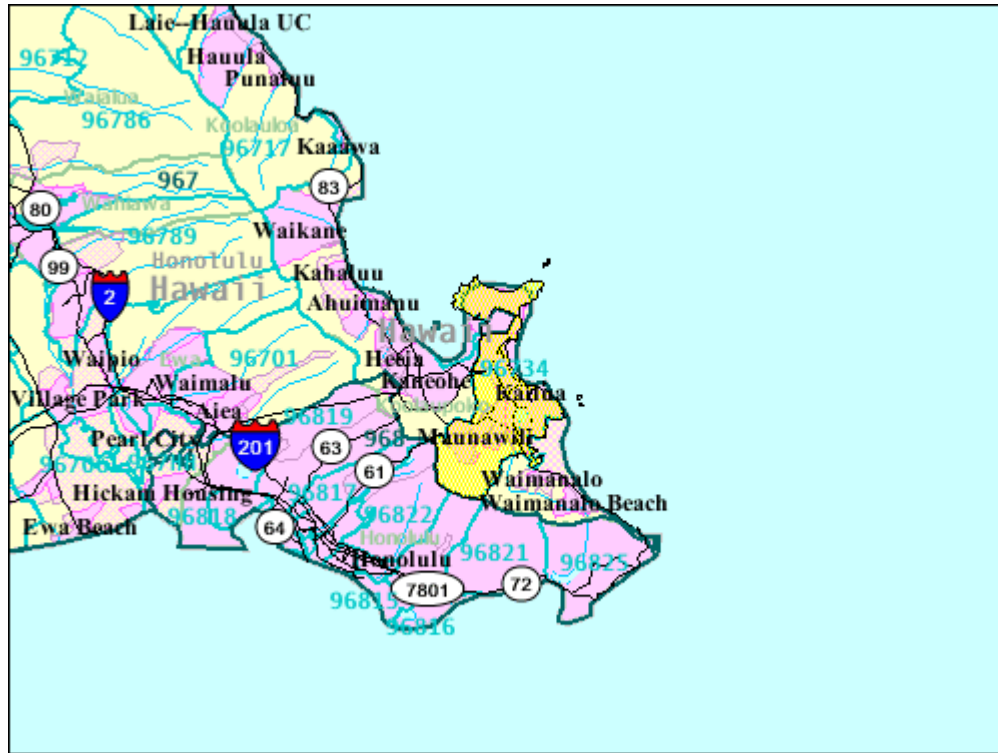
