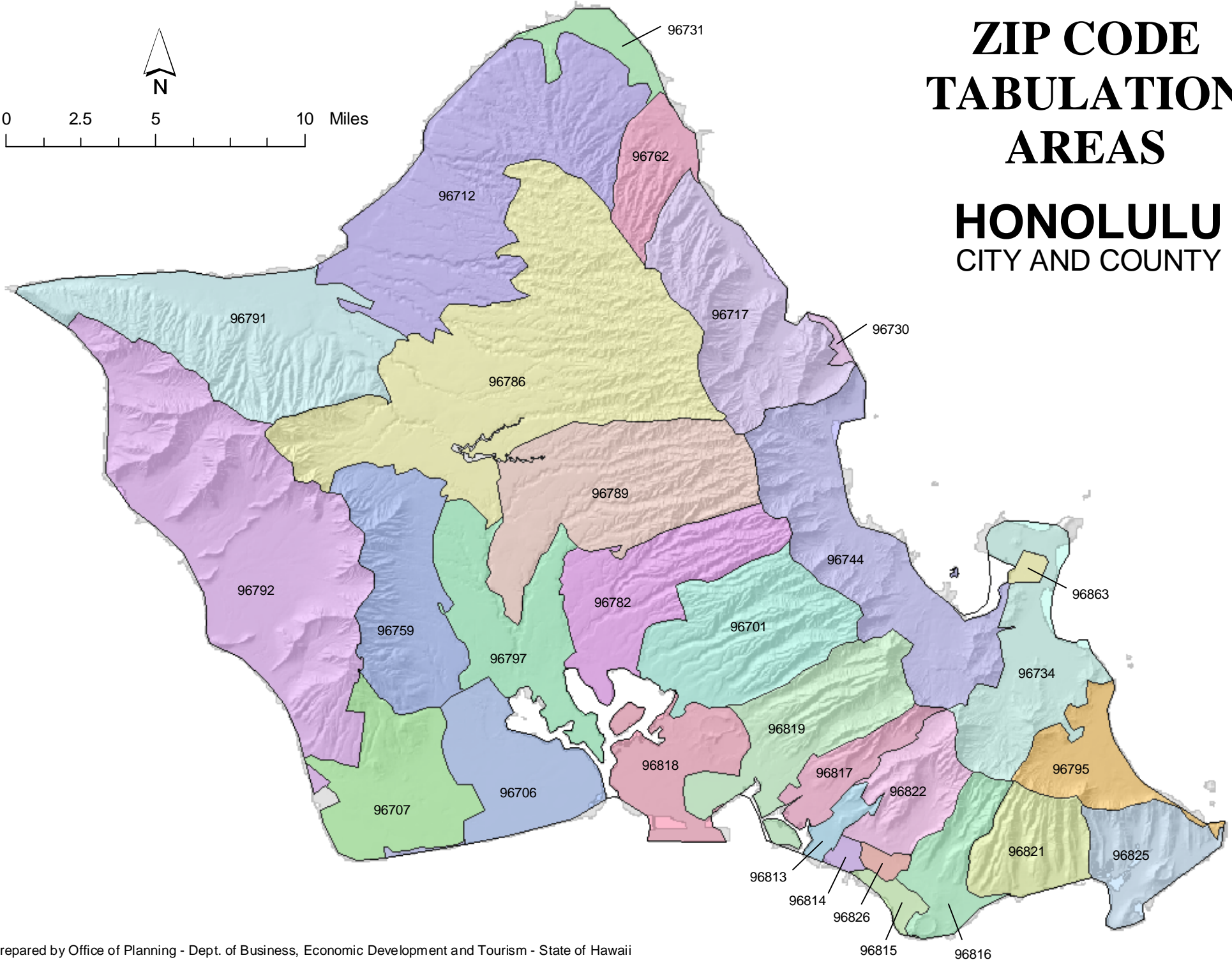
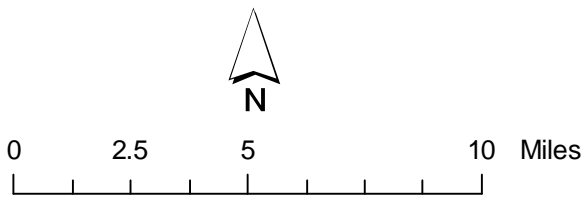

HONOLULU CITY AND COUNTY







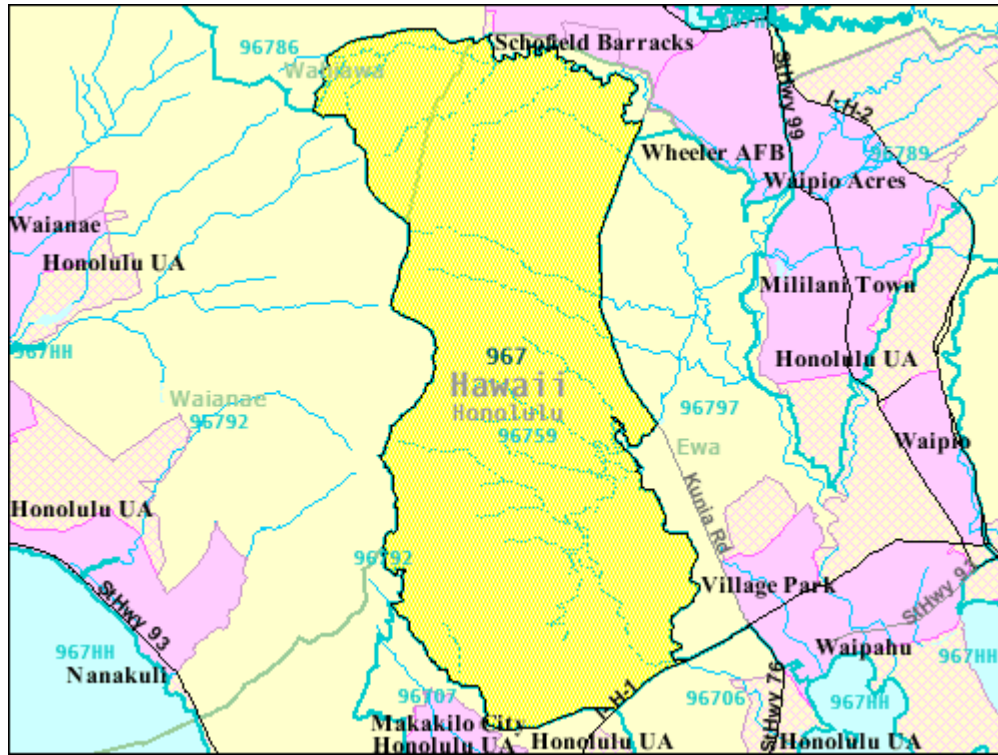
